

## **HK OVERNIGHT CAMP INFORMATION**

### Who:


Overnight camp is for children in Grade 4-6 (if your Grade 4-6 child does not want to stay overnight, they are still welcome to attend our Day Camp). If for any reason your child is not going to stay both nights, please let us know so that we can make transport arrangements.

### When:

Overnight Camp will run Tuesday 9th of April - Thursday 11th of April. Drop off is from 8:00am on Day 1 (Tuesday the 9th) at either Highway Ormeau or Highway Gilston. Children dropped off to Highway Ormeau will be transported to and from Highway Gilston by bus, the bus will leave at 9am on Day 1. Highway Kids leaders will travel on buses with the children. Children from Ormeau will arrive back at Highway Ormeau by 4:30pm on Day 3 (Thursday the 11th) and must be picked up by 5pm.

# **HK OVERNIGHT CAMP INFORMATION**

### What to expect:

Children will engage in a range of fun games and activities as well as participate in Highway Kids services including campfire sessions and nighttime games. Children will be supervised by Highway Kids leaders at a ratio of 1:15 (one Highway Kids leader to every 15 children). Highway Kids leaders are equipped with blue cards and a number of them have first aid certificates.

Children will be sleeping in the Highway Kids rooms at Gilston. One room for boys and one for girls. Highway Kids leaders will sleep in a separate room but will keep a roster of leaders (of the same gender) supervising throughout the night should the children require anything.

Both toilets and showers are already provided at Highway Gilston. The main toilet block is located a short walk from the sleeping rooms, however there is a 'rustic' loo next to the sleeping rooms and Highway Kids leaders will be available to walk children to the main toilet block during the night should they wish to use it. There is one hot shower next to the main toilets and a schedule will be provided for children to use it throughout the morning/evening.
